DATES OF MATCH: Saturday, January 8, 2022

CITY / STATE LOCATION: Jacksonville State University – Jacksonville, Alabama

ELIGIBILITY: This competition is open to all competitors born in 2002 or later. All competitors **must** be individual members of USA Shooting.

RESIDENCE: Each competitor may claim residence in only one state and must declare the state of residence on the entry form. Residents are eligible for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place USA Shooting State Champion medallions. Residency is defined as to where the competitor holds a current and valid driver's license. If the competitor does not have a drivers license, residency is then defined as to where the competitor's parents/guardians reside. Non-residents may compete for invitations to the National Championship and are encouraged to do so. Non-residents are not eligible for state awards.

ENTRY: Only scores from a registered State Junior Olympic match will count for invitation to the National Junior Olympic Championships. Shooters **may not** compete in more than one state JOSOC. Juniors who fire in their own home state JOSOC will not be allowed to shoot in another state. Juniors from states which are not holding a state JOSOC and those who cannot attend their own state JOSOC will be allowed to enter as a non-resident in another state. Non-residents should declare their home state at entry and are not eligible for state resident awards.

Residency is defined as to where the competitor holds a current and valid driver's license. If the competitor does not have a driver's license, residency is then defined as to where the competitors parents/guardians reside.

TEAMS: This is an individual competition. No team entries will be accepted.

CATEGORIES: The following categories will be used for individual competition:
(Based on the age of the competitor on the date of the match.)
Junior (U21; formerly J1): under 21
Intermediate Junior (U18; formerly J2): under 18

Sub-Junior (U14; formerly J3): under 14

RULES: **CURRENT ISSF RULES WILL BE USED.**

COURSE OF FIRE: Indoor, Standing, 60 shots for Women and Men.

TIME LIMIT: Firing time allowed will be: 1 hour, 15 minutes
A 15-minute preparation and sighting period will begin prior to the official start time of the event.

FIREARM: 0.177 caliber air rifles which meet ISSF rules.

SIGHTS: Iron sights

DISTANCE: 10 meters

TARGETS: Electronic AR-5, 10 meter targets will be used.

COACHING: Coaching on the firing line will **not** be permitted.

SCORING

PROTESTS: A scoring protest of \$1.00 per shot may be charged.

TIES: All ties will be broken in accordance with ISSF rules.

PARTICIPATION

PINS: A Junior Olympic participation pin provided by USA Shooting will be given to each competitor.

AWARDS: USA Shooting will provide a gold medallion for the top-scoring resident individual, a silver medallion for the 2nd place resident individual, and a bronze medallion for the 3rd place resident individual for both male and female categories.

Shelby County Shooting Sports Association will provide medals for the 1st place individual male and female in each age category (U21, U18, and U14).

SCORE SHEETS: **Special score sheets must be used for all State JOSCs.** They are to be filled in completely and signed by the competitor to be considered for invitation to the National JOSC. **LEGIBLE** handwriting is required. If we cannot read your handwriting you may not get your invitation.

ENTRY FEES: \$20.00 per shooter

ENTRIES CLOSE: Entries received by January 4 will be accepted to range capacity. Every effort will be made to accept all competitors who wish to enter.

POST ENTRIES: Entries made after the closing date will be accepted if space is available.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellations received one week in advance, or earlier, will receive a full refund.
